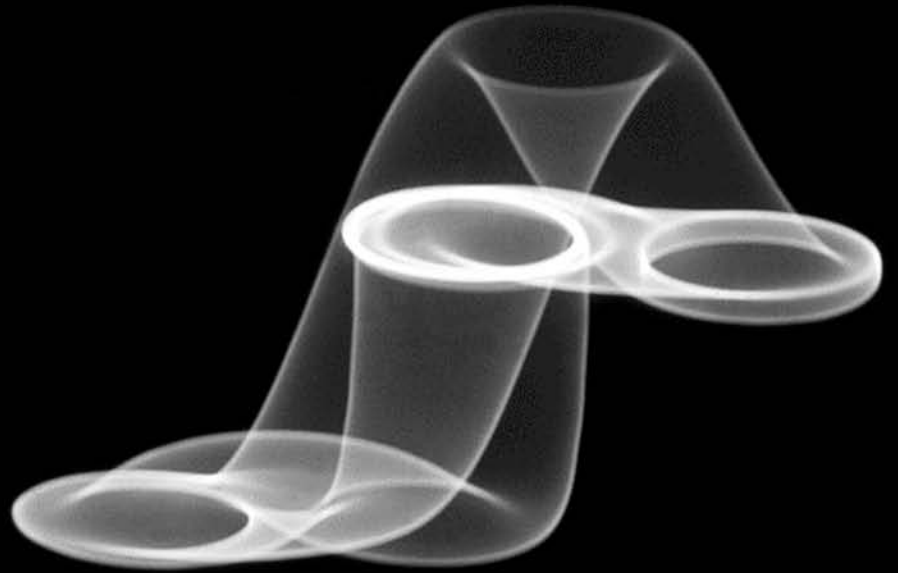


KINETICA ART FAIR 2009
